

I have been directed to inform you that on the basis of the report of the Inspection Committee dated 04.04.2025, the Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to grant extension/continuation in provisional affiliation in LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year, B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year and BBA LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year Programs with an intake of 60 seats in each program for the session 2025-26 and grant of provisional affiliation for increase in intake in LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year, B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year and BBA LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year Program from 60 to 120 seats in each program subject to approval of Central Body i.e. Bar Council of India, New Delhi. The Vice-Chancellor further granted provisional affiliation for introduction of LL.M. Program with an intake of 30 seats for the session 2025-26 to your College.

The above extension/continuation in provisional affiliation, increase in intake as well as grant of provisional affiliation for introduction of LL.M. Program is granted with the condition to strict & timely compliance of the deficiencies as pointed out by the Inspection Committee. INSPECTION COMMITTEE REPORT

Inspection Report of J.C. College of Law, Village Lowa Khurd, Bahadurgargh, Distt. Jhajjar regarding checking of compliance report-matter regarding grant of Extension/Continuation in provisional affiliation in LL.B. (Hons.) 3years B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 years BBA LL.B. (Hons.), 5 years program with an intake of 60 seats in each program and grant of provisional affiliation for introduction of LL.M program with an intake of 120 seats and increase in intake of LL.B. (Hons.) 3 years, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 years, BBA LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year program from 60 to 120 seats in each program for the session 2025-26 at J.C. College of Law, Village Lowa Khurd, Bahadurgargh, Distt. Jhajjar

The Inspection Committee comprising of the following faculty members visited the above-mentioned Institute on 04.04.2025 to check the compliance report-matter of Extension/Continuation in provisional affiliation with increase in intake and introduction of LL.M program for the session 2025-26 as mentioned above.

Observations of the Committee: After physical verification of the necessary infrastructure requirements and going through the compliance of the previous committee report for the above-mentioned programmes the committee noticed the following observations:


1. **Compliance of the earlier inspection committee report:** The college provided the information of the earlier inspection committee compliance report that visited on 10-01-2024 for the BBA LLB (Hons.) 5 Year, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year, and LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year with the intake of 60 seats for the session 2024-25. After going through the compliance it was found that college has partially fulfilled the compliance suggested by the previous inspection committee report.
2. **Appointment of Teaching Staff:-** As per information with supportive documents given by Principal-cum-Professor, Dr. Sushil Kumar Sharma, the college has taken permission from Bar Council of India to run the following courses BBA LLB (Hons.) 5 Year, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year, and LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year with the intake of 60 seats for the session 2024-25 and the required faculty as per norms the college has 22 faculty members for BBA LLB (Hons.) 5 Year, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year, and LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year which are appointed only by the college and are not approved as per the university norms (5 Professors, 3 Associate Professors, 14 Assistant Professors). The college has also identified 23 faculty members including 1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor and 20 Assistant Professors for the extension and introduction of new courses for the session 2025-26.



3. **Appointment of Non-teaching Staff:** The college has appointed 17 non-teaching staff members (including 01 Librarian, 01 Assistant Librarian, 01 Library Attendant, 01 Lab In-Charge, 01 clerk, 03 peon, 02 sweepers, 02 Security men, 01 Placement and training Officer, 01 Data Entry Operator) to run the college.
4. **College Library:** The College has 4200 books with 1244 titles for the existing and proposed program (i.e. LLM Program) for the session 2025-26. The library needs to be strengthened by providing issue/return counter, photocopier machine, printer, new arrival corner, magazines and news papers of Hindi and English.
5. **NAAC/NBA:** The College is yet to be initiated for the accreditation of NAAC / NBA.
6. **Building:** The Institute has a multi-storey building, including Principal office, Admin offices, academic block, library, computer labs, classrooms, tutorial rooms, common rooms, Seminar Halls, toilets, etc.
7. **Placement Cell:** The College has to set up a placement cell with required infrastructure and a Placement Offices to get the students placed in the corporate sector.
8. **Computer Lab:** The Institute has established one computer lab with 55 computers and 4 printers for various programs. The Institute has an Internet connection of 500 MBPS lease line from eco web.
9. **Classrooms:** The Institute has adequate furnished classrooms and seminar room for the current programs and the purposed programe for effective teaching-learning practices.
10. **General Facilities:** The Institute has all other general facilities such as drinking water, washrooms for boys and girls, first aid room, canteen etc. on the campus required for the smooth running of the programs.
11. **Inspection Performas:** The Inspection proformas of all the program; BBA LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year, LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year and LL.M program are duly filled, signed and enclosed with all documentary proofs.
12. **Common Rooms for Boys and Girls:** The College has separate common room for boys and girls which are fully furnished.
13. **Governing Body:** The College has still to constitute governing body as per university norms.


Recommendations:- The committee recommends that J.C. College of Law, Village Lowa Khurd, Bahadurgargh, Distt. Jhajjar may be granted the following:


1. Extension/Continuation in Provisional affiliation for LL.B. (Hons.) 3 year, B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year, BBA LL.B. (Hons.) 5 year with intake of existing 60 seats only for the session 2025-26. *and increase in intake from 60 to 120 seats in above Courses subject to approval of BCI.*
2. Provisional affiliation for introduction of LL.M. Program with intake of 30 seats for the session 2025-26.




